### 1. Who was Nuh (عليه السلام)?

He was a Prophet and Messenger of Allah (عليه السلام).

إِنَّا أَرْسَلْنَا نُوحًا إِلَىٰ قَوْمِهِ<sup>٢</sup> أَنْ أَنْذِرْ قَوْمَكَ مِنْ قَبْلِ أَنْ يَأْتِيَهُمْ عَذَابٌ أَلِيمٌ

### 2. In the first verse of Surah Nuh, Allah described why Nuh had been sent as a messenger to his people. What was that reason?

The reason was to warn them before a severe punishment came to them.

قَالَ يَاقَوْمِ إِنِّي لَكُمْ نَذِيرٌ مُّبِينٌ

### 3. How did Nuh (عليه السلام) address his nation?

He told them that he was sent to them as a clear warner.

أَنْ أَعْبُدُوا اللَّهَ وَاتَّقَوْهُ وَأَطِيعُونَ

### 4. What did Nuh (عليه السلام) ask his people to do?

To worship Allah, fear Him, and obey Him.

يَغْفِرَ لَكُمْ مِنْ ذُنُوبِكُمْ وَيُؤَخِّرْكُمْ إِلَىٰ أَجَلٍ مُّسَمًّى<sup>٣</sup> إِنَّ أَجَلَ اللَّهِ إِذَا جَاءَ لَا يُؤَخَّرُ<sup>طَلُو</sup>  
كُنْتُمْ تَعْلَمُونَ

### 5. What will Allah do if you follow what Nuh (عليه السلام) said in the previous verse?

He will forgive your sins and extend your life (by Allah's punishment not falling upon you). [Tafseer Ibn Katheer]

**6. What happens if Allah commands the destruction of a nation?**

It cannot be prevented from occurring or delayed at all.

قَالَ رَبِّ إِنِّي دَعَوْتُ قَوْمِي لَيْلًا وَنَهَارًا

**7. How much effort did Nuh (عليه السلام) spend in calling his people?**

He called them day and night.

فَلَمْ يَزِدْهُمْ دُعَائِي إِلَّا فِرَارًا

**8. Were people attracted to his message?**

No, but rather they fled from it and avoided it.

وَإِنِّي كُلَّمَا دَعَوْتُهُمْ لِتَغْفِرَ لَهُمْ جَعَلُوا أَصَابِعَهُمْ فِي آذَانِهِمْ وَاسْتَغْشَوْا ثِيَابَهُمْ  
وَأَصْرُوا وَأَسْتَكْبَرُوا وَاسْتَكْبَرُوا

**9. How did people respond to his message?**

They used to put their fingers in their ears, cover themselves with their garments, persisted on disbelief, and increased themselves in arrogance.

ثُمَّ إِنِّي دَعَوْتُهُمْ جِهَارًا

ثُمَّ إِنِّي أَعْلَنْتُ لَهُمْ وَأَسْرَرْتُ لَهُمْ إِسْرَارًا

**10. In which ways did Nuh (عليه السلام) invite his nation?**

Nuh (عليه السلام) invited them openly, in public, and in private.

**11. What are two blessings that many people are deceived and tested with?**

Health and free time. [Bukhari 6412]

**12. How should you be in this world?**

Like a stranger or a traveler. [Nawawi 40]

**13. With regards to character, what is the Deen?**

An-Naseehah (advice/sincerity)

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "The deen (religion) is naseehah (advice, sincerity)." We said, "To whom?" He (ﷺ) said, "To Allah, His Book, His Messenger, and to the leaders of the Muslims and their common folk." [Muslim]

A) Surah Nur

**15. Into how many languages of the world has the Holy Quraan been translated?**

A) Nearly 103 languages.

**16. Who was the first ruler of the first Islamic state?**
